- Friday 27 August from 6.00pm 9.00pm Rehearsal 2 at Victoria Hall/Bethesda Gardens

Performance Day:

- Saturday 28 August from 9.30am (full dress rehearsal)
- Performances: 3pm, 3.30pm, 4pm, 4.30, 5pm, 5.30pm, 6pm

A **Handbag talk** will take place on **Sunday 1 August 1.30-2.30pm** at **New Vic Theatre** and we'd encourage all participants to attend. This is your chance to meet Geraldine and find out more about the project.

Please note that all performers should be over the age of 16 and while it is not necessary to have any previous dance experience you will need to be able to follow instruction and take direction independently.
